

RAIN GUTTER REGATTA REGULATIONS



All boats must be made from an official BSA regatta kit.

1. Races will be double elimination.
2. Boats cannot be touched after each race starts.
3. Boats will be powered by the participant blowing into the sail.
4. The race is complete when the boat touches the end of the gutter.
5. 1st thru 4th place will be awarded.
6. Best design will be awarded. Be creative.
7. Siblings are invited to race
8. Pirate costume judging contest will be at the end of the race.

Bring a copy of your registration with you to show at the event.

The Boat Challenge event is outdoors with lots of sun. There are no stores close by so please plan ahead to have an enjoyable time. Entrance at the Lake Pleasant regional park costs \$6.00 per vehicle. Carpooling is recommended. Spectator tickets are \$2.00 at the event. Custom Event patches are available for \$3.00. Patches are included for all participants in the boat challenge race, and rain gutter regatta. There will be a snack shack (cash only). A shaded area by headquarters for handicapped spectators as the trail down to the lake may not be accessible.

This list is provided to help you “be prepared” for the event.

Spectators and Participants should bring:

- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- Camp chair
- Shade, umbrella, small easy up etc.
- Water
- Lunch.
- Cash for park entrance, snacks, drinks and event patches etc.

Boat Challenge Participants will also need to bring:

- Personal floatation device (Life vest)
- Towel
- Change of clothes
- Repair tools like, tape, rope, etc.
- All paperwork for registration
