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Check – In Procedure

- A. All Scouts must have the following forms completed and presented at camp registration prior to entering camp:
 - a. Shooting Sports Permission Slip
 - b. BSA Medical Form Part A & B
- B. If these items are not completed before check in, they will be required to be completed upon arrival before your scout will be able to participate in camp activities. This is a BSA National Policy so we cannot make any exceptions.

Medical

- A. Medical Forms A & B must be presented before a scout can enter camp and participate in camp activities.
- B. ALL PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION MUST BE IN THE ORIGINAL BOTTLE WITH INSTRUCTIONS.
- C. If there are any special needs or disabilities that need specific attention, they must be stated in your registration on Black Pug. Please let us know as soon as possible so we can accommodate the needs of our participants. Please email them to MobileAreaCubScouts@gmail.com If an email is not sent, there is no guarantee that needs will be met.

Campsites

- A. All tent setup will be first come, first serve.
- B. Vehicles are not allowed at your campsite. They are restricted to the roads and Parking Area.
- C. See Map for tent setup locations.
- D. There are three Single Occupant Shower Rooms available.

Attire

- A. Wear Field Uniform to Opening Ceremony & Campfire Ceremony. Activity Uniform for remaining time.
- B. ONLY closed toe shoes with socks for YOUTH and STAFF! No sandals, flip flops, or crocs (this is for safety).
- C. Please be weather aware and bring appropriate attire for the temperatures forecasted. This is a rain or shine event. April weather in Mobile can vary a lot, so “Be Prepared.”

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Volunteers

- A. All adult Volunteers need to complete Safeguarding Youth Training (SYT) on my.scouting.org and send your completion certificate to MobileAreaCubScouts@gmail.com. These need to be on file before you interact with the youth during camp.
- B. **If you are an Adult or a Youth Volunteer Staff Member, please plan to attend the Staff Orientation, Sunday April 29th via Zoom at 4 pm.
- C. Adult Staff that will be on the range will need Range training. Contact the Camp Director directly if you are interested in helping with shooting sports.

Outdoor Challenge Ranking
