



COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM

Scouts aged 14 & 15 who have an interest in serving R-C Scout Ranch as a Counselor in Training (CIT) will experience curriculum that is aimed to develop their leadership, customer service, teaching and self.

The CIT group will function as a patrol, with the CIT director reinforcing scouting methods and enabling the youth to have real leadership opportunities as they grow together learning about communication, goal setting, team building, and personal accountability. CIT's will be challenged to "reach higher" to get to know themselves and how capable they can be in every setting. While the CIT program runs the entirety of the R-C Family Camp season, they will have plenty of opportunities for games and special activities during their stay.

The CIT participants will have an opportunity to rotate through the core Family Camp activities and learn from the Family Camp staff. Ideally, they rotate through all the core activities but if they show an interest in a specific area, they can spend more time in that area.
