Waiver and Release

BSA merit badge workshop | May 3-4, 2025

Central Arizona Water Conservation District (CAWCD) is engaged in operating the Central Arizona Project (CAP), an aqueduct system consisting of a canal and other large infrastructures, by which their very nature is potentially hazardous and dangerous to those who are present during operation. Notwithstanding the hazards and potential dangers, members of Boy Scouts of America, Grand Canyon Council, have been invited to the CAP Headquarters located at 23636 N 7th St, Phoenix AZ 85024 on Saturday May 3 and/or Sunday, May 4, 2025, for the purpose of a merit badge workshop that will involve walking through and around the 10-acre campus of the facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the undersigned gaining entry onto and into CAP property and CAP Facilities, and receiving permission from CAWCD to attend the workshop, the undersigned hereby:

1. Acknowledges that he/she voluntarily assumes and accepts all risks of injury or death to himself/herself and any minor child of which he/she is a parent or legal guardian, and loss of or damage to his/her property, arising out of or occurring while at any and all CAP facilities and/or while observing the operations at any and all CAP facilities;
2. Releases and holds harmless the United States, CAWCD and its directors, officers, other agents, contractors and employees from any and all liability, claims and causes of action, including attorneys' fees, arising out of either directly or indirectly related to any injury to himself/herself or minor child for which they are legally responsible or loss of his/her property, occurring while on the premises of any CAP Facility and/or while observing any of the operations at CAP;
3. Agrees not to photograph, film, or video-record any equipment or locations at or within any CAP facility without the express permission of an authorized CAP employee;
4. Agrees to abide by all of CAWCD's rules relating to safety and further agrees that such compliance does not relieve him/her from the terms of this Agreement.
5. In the event of a medical emergency, CAWCD has permission to administer appropriate medical assistance and to have me or my child transported to the nearest emergency facility. My contact phone number is _____.
