Christmas in June / Req. 6 – Participate in a service project. Explain how your volunteering is helpful to your neighborhood.

Paws On The Path (Outdoors) – Required Adventure

Animal Rescue / Req. 2 – Learn about the buddy system and how it works in the outdoors. Pick a buddy for your walk.

Air of the Wolf – Elective Adventure
