Overview

General Information

The benefit of Arrow of Light (AOL) attending Maverick Camporee is to participate in a weekend campout in a Scouts BSA environment and hopefully get excited for their future outdoor experiences in Scouts BSA.

An AOL Patrol may have a Troop host them, which could include sharing meals and equipment. If you do not have contact for a host Troop and would like to work with one send an email to MaverickCamporee@gmail.com.

All attendees are required to have a complete Scouting America Medical Form, part A and B and Activity Consent Form for all Scouts in attendance, even if the parent is present. The AOL leader should have access to these while at camp. You will not turn the forms in, but the medical forms should always be accessible in the event of an emergency.

Guidelines for AOL Scouts Participation at Maverick Camporee

As indicated in the Guide to Safe Scouting, AOL Scouts may participate at a Scouts BSA “camporee” as an Arrow of Light patrol under the supervision of two deep leadership from their AOL patrol or pack. The AOL Scout’s parent /legal guardian(s) may attend with the AOL patrol and their child, either alongside the two-deep leadership or as part of it if they are registered with the pack.

Participants:

Maverick Camporee is open to AOL Scouts, Scouts BSA, Crews and Sea Scouts. This is not a family camp, therefore only the AOL Scouts and Parent(s)/Guardian(s) may attend (no siblings).

Pets are not allowed and will be asked to leave camp.

Campsites:

Campsites will be assigned based on the needs of all units. Campsite requests at time of registration will be considered.

Meals and Camping Equipment:

Each AOL unit is responsible for their own food and its preparation and camping equipment. As previously mentioned, this could be shared with a host Troop

Transportation:

Each AOL Patrol is responsible for their own transportation. The Patrol should arrive together. If the AOL Patrol does have a Host Troop, they should coordinate arriving at the same time.

Vehicle Parking:

All vehicles are to remain in the parking lot at Camp Geronimo, with the exception that one vehicle per unit will be allowed to transport gear to the designated campsite. Once the gear has been unloaded at the campsite, that vehicle must return to the parking lot. **All vehicles must have a dash sign filled out and placed on the dash. All vehicles must be backed in for emergency departure if needed.**

Medical Services/First Aid:

The Camp Health Lodge is staffed 24 hours a day by qualified medical personnel. Each unit should have its own first aid kit and be prepared to treat minor injuries. Units are the first line for treatment of minor injuries. For insurance purposes and for the health and safety of all participants, all accidents and illnesses, no matter how minor, must be reported to the Health Lodge and recorded.

Uniforms:

Uniforms are an important part of Scouting and Maverick Weekend. The official scout uniform should be worn during travel to and from camp, Saturday night campfire, and Sunday morning closing ceremony. Saturday opening ceremonies, AOL Adventures and service project will be in your designated activity uniform (class B).

Headquarters:

Camporee Headquarters will be at the Camp Health Lodge.

Has your Patrol worked on their Patrol Name, Patrol Cheer, Patrol Flag? This is a great event to really show your Patrol Spirit.

Weekend Activities

Friday Night Activities:

Check-In:

Check-in at the Geronimo gatehouse Friday September 26th from 6:00pm-9:00pm. If you arrive after 9:00pm, please proceed to the dining hall.

Leader(s) please complete and turn in the unit roster found on the last page of this guide.

After check-in proceed to your campsite and set-up camp. Quiet time is 10:00pm.

Saturday Activities:

Opening:

Opening Flag Ceremony 7:30am at the Flag poles. (activity uniform)

AOL Games:

AOL's will participate in "AOL Adventures" Saturday morning. Location to be announced. While the AOL are attending the AOL Games, the Troops will be participating in their own skill events for the morning. (activity uniform)

Service Project:

Service project details will be available prior to lunch break. All participants should bring work gloves. (activity uniform)

Skits and Songs:

Patrols interested in performing a skit/song at Saturday night campfire must come prepared and well-practiced. Auditions will take place on Saturday 3:30pm – 4:15pm in the dining hall. Not all skits/songs may be selected. (activity uniform)

Campfire:

The campfire program will begin at 7:30pm at the main campfire ring. (Field Uniform)

Sunday Activities:

Interfaith Service and Closing Awards:

Interfaith Service and Closing Awards will be held at the main campfire ring at 9:00am. The morning will begin with a short Interfaith service, immediately followed with the closing awards. (Field Uniform)

Check-Out:

Before leaving Camp Geronimo, every unit must completely police their area. Pick up, throw away and pack out all the trash. Don't leave anything behind. Make sure the campsite is better than you found it. The campsite must be inspected by camporee staff. Once released, units can pick up their patches at the gatehouse.
