

BAGDAD OPERATIONS SITE ACCESS ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

In compliance with Federal Mine standards, it is necessary for all mines to alert persons visiting or doing business on mining property of certain dangers they may encounter. Listed are some dos and don'ts along with a map of roads you are to follow.

HAZARDS

1. All heavy equipment, as well as slow moving machinery has the right-of-way.
2. Blasting does occur on-site - stay on main access roads only.
3. Just watered or rain soaked roads can become slick.
4. Be aware of rough roads and rocks in road.

DON'TS

1. **DO NOT** leave the main road unless escorted by a supervisor or other authorized person.
2. **DO NOT** talk or text on cell phone while driving on FMBI property.
3. **DO NOT** go into the pit area unless you have completed the Pit Driving Course.
4. **DO NOT** stop your vehicle to sight see, pick up rocks, etc. Go directly to your area of business.
5. **DO NOT PASS ANY TRUCKS MARKED EXPLOSIVES.**
6. **DO NOT** operate any Freeport Bagdad McMoRan (FMBI) equipment unless certified under MSHA standards and have permission from FMBI Management.
7. **DO NOT** operate any unsafe equipment.
8. **MINE LAW PROHIBITS** the use or possession of drugs or alcohol or being under the influence of either on mining property. No weapons of any kind are allowed on mine property. These rules are strictly enforced; any violation of these rules can revoke your future privileges of entry to Freeport McMoRan-Bagdad mining property.

DO'S

1. **ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE MINE MUST WEAR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)** - hard hat, safety glasses, safety vest, full-length pants, sleeved shirt, closed-toe shoes - at all times. Hard toe shoes will be worn in required areas.
2. **ALL ROADS PAST THE MAIN GATE ARE LEFT HAND - DRIVE AS POSTED.**
3. **MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT ON ALL MINING PROPERTY IS 35 MPH** or less if posted or due to conditions (traffic, weather, and road surfaces).
4. It is mandatory to obey all traffic control signs. You must **STOP** at all stop signs and/or a Flag person.
5. Failure to drive or work safely can result in denial of access.
6. **Head lights on for safety at all times while on company property.**
7. **Seatbelts must always be worn while in a moving vehicle or mobile equipment.**
8. **TO REPORT A SPILL ON MINE PROPERTY, CONTACT THE SECURITY GATE AT (928) 633-3211 or VIA RADIO MINE CHANNELS 1 OR 2 IMMEDIATELY.**
9. **IF YOU NEED TO REPORT A MINE EMERGENCY, CALL (928) 633-6567.**
