	Wolf: Fire <b>5 BBs</b> at the target and score your target. <b>Repeat twice</b> and do your best to improve your score. Fire at least <b>15 BBs</b> .					
	Bear: Fire <b>5 BBs</b> at the target and score your target. <b>Repeat twice</b> and do your best to improve your score. Fire at least <b>15 BBs</b> .					
	Webelos: Shoot <b>5 shots</b> at a target. <b>Repeat three times</b> and do your best to improve your score each time. Shoot at least <b>20 BBs</b> .					
	AOL: Shoot <b>5 shots</b> at a target. <b>Repeat three times</b> and do your best to improve your score each time. Shoot at least <b>20 BBs</b> .					
8	Discuss how to put away and properly store your BB gun and shooting equipment after use.

6	Shooting Requirements: <i>Rangemaster Note: The arrows do not have to be shot in one session but may be spread across multiple sessions.</i>						
	Lion: Shoot <b>2 arrows</b> at target. <b>Repeat</b> and try to improve your score. A minimum of <b>4 arrows</b> are shot.						
	Tiger: Shoot <b>3 arrows</b> at target. <b>Repeat</b> and try to improve your score. A minimum of <b>6 arrows</b> are shot.						
	Wolf: Shoot <b>5 arrows</b> at target. <b>Repeat</b> and try to improve your score. A minimum of <b>10 arrows</b> are shot.						
	Bear: Shoot <b>5 arrows</b> at a target. <b>Repeat two times</b> and do your best to improve your score each time. Shoot at least <b>15 arrows</b> .						
	Webelos: Shoot <b>5 arrows</b> at target. <b>Repeat three times</b> and try to improve your score. A minimum of <b>20 arrows</b> are shot.						
	AOL: Shoot <b>5 arrows</b> at target. <b>Repeat four times</b> and try to improve your score. A minimum of <b>25 arrows</b> are shot.						
7	Demonstrate how to safely retrieve your arrows.						
8	Discuss how to put away and properly store your archery shooting equipment after use.

	Bear: Shoot <b>5 shots</b> at a target. <b>Repeat twice</b> and do your best to improve your score each time. Shoot at least <b>15 shots</b> .
