ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Graduating high school senior
- Earned the Eagle Scout rank, or received approval for an Eagle Project from the Eagle Board of Review by September 30, 2026, with verification
- Enrolled in a public, private, or home school program in Alameda, Contra Costa, or Solano County
- Minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Two signed letters of recommendation
- Official high school transcript
- SAT or ACT score(s)
- Plan to enroll full-time in an accredited four-year college or university in Fall 2027
- Registered for this AMBU event
- Register for and attend National AMBU Day in Hayward on October 3, 2026
- Participate on the Real Talk Eagle Scout Panel
- Be present for the scholarship award presentation

ESSAY REQUIREMENT

Write a 500–700 word essay on: How has earning, or working toward, the Eagle Scout rank shaped the leader you are becoming, and how will you use your education to create measurable, lasting service in your community? Explain how your future plans reflect at least two AMBU values: advancement, accessible opportunity, leadership, scholarship and learning, college/career readiness, mentorship, or service.
