Webelos/AOL Adventure Camp

While Scouts may seem like a long way off, the adventure is just around the corner. Webelos/AOL Adventure Camp is a chance for your Scout to get a taste of what Scout is really like. Each Webelos/AOL and adult partner, called an Akela, will participate in camp activities. They will also share meals and enjoy a campfire program. The cost is \$110 a pair (Webelos/AOL & Akela) and \$55 for an adult with his/her den/pack. Each Scout-Akela pair will receive a patch that signifies their participation in this year's Webelos/AOL Adventure Camp. The camp will provide all meals and overnight tent and mattress setup for this exciting program. Indian Village and Yuma are the reserved campsites.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

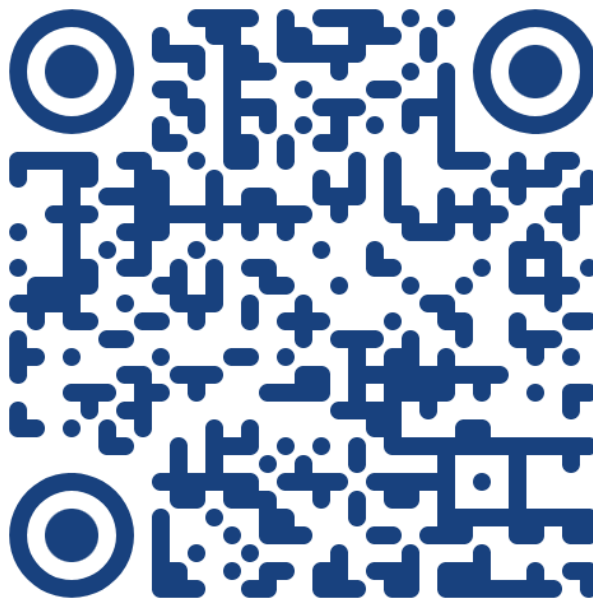
Webelos/AOL Should Bring...

- » Your toothbrush, toothpaste, and other toiletries
- » A jacket as nights are cool
- » A rain coat, just in case
- » Closed toed shoes, & hat
- » Medication, & Annual Health and Medical Record parts A and B

Additionally, Akelas Should Bring...

- » The same gear as your Webelos/AOL
- » Folding chair for you and your Scout
- » A water bottle
- » Flashlight/Headlamp
- » Medication, & Annual Health and Medical Record parts A and B
- » Wagon to get items from car to campsite.
