Applicant Eligibility:

- Be a current or past registered member of the Southern Sierra Council.
- Must be a member of the Southern Sierra Council 2022 Class of Eagle Scouts.
- There is no age requirement for this scholarship.
- The scholarship may only be used for higher education (college or trade school). All funds will be paid directly to the recipient's selected school upon their enrollment and request for payment. All funds will be kept in a custodial account until the funds are requested.
- Candidate must apply for scholarship using this application.
- Complete the application and return along with a minimum 250-word essay on "What being an Eagle Scout means to me". A personal interview may be requested.

- Essay – “What Being an Eagle Scout Mean to me” – Minimum 250-words.
- Eagle Scout Project – Minimum 200-word description of your Eagle project.
- Your Life’s Goals & Aspirations – Minimum 200-words.
