

## **NYLT Staff Information Sheet 2020**

National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) provides youth leaders with leadership and teambuilding skills to manager Troop/Crew programs. As a previous participant, you have already experienced this valuable training which includes the stages of team development as well as a toolbox of additional leadership skills such as planning, conflict resolution and evaluation.

We are currently recruiting youth and adult staff positions for the 2020 NYLT Southern Sierra Council course. This is a great opportunity to provide service to your council and to other youth in the Scouting program. It is also an opportunity to enhance your own leadership, communication and servant leadership skills regardless of whether you are a youth or an adult.

## Details for consideration are as follows:

- **1-** Youth must be at least 14 years old and have previously completed the NYLT course successfully.
- 2- Youth must have completed the NYLT Challenge requirements (or be in progress and complete by 4/4/2020).
- **3-** Youth <u>and</u> Adult- Be available to participate in staff development days as follows to prepare for the event:
  - a. 4/4 Staff Orientation (Scout Office)
  - b. 4/25-26- Staff Development (EDGE Training Sat/Scout Office Sun)
  - c. **5/16-17** Staff Development (Scout Office)
  - d. 6/13-14- Staff Development (Campout at Camp Kern)
  - e. 6/20-21- Set Up at Camp Kern
  - f. 6/22-27- Mon-Sat- NYLT Course at Camp Kern
- 4- Youth and Adult- Pay Staff Fee of \$150 (or arrange for sponsorship)
  - a. Fee includes food/supplies throughout Staff Development days and course, Jacket, Hat, Neckerchief, slide, t-shirt and materials for course.

## Youth Positions available are:

- 1- Troop SPL & ASPL- Primary youth leaders for course, presents at least 1-2 presentations and prefer previous experience as NYLT staff in some capacity,
- **2- Troop Guide-** leadership presents at least 1-2 presentations and works with individual patrol throughout course
- **3- Troop Scribe-** Assists SPL and ASM of Program with communication, technology, newsletters and presents at least 1 presentation.
- **4- Troop Quartermaster –** Assists ASM of Service with supplies and equipment throughout course and presents 1-2 presentations

Adult Staff Positions are also needed for ASM Service, ASM Program, Quartermaster and Meal Coordinator positions. ASM Positions require Woodbadge training however other support coordinator positions do not.
