WHAT is NYLT?

National Youth Leadership Training is an exciting, action-packed program designed to provide youth members of the Boy Scouts of America with leadership skills and experiences they can use in their home unit and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. This outdoor experience is set up to represent a month in the life of a typical scout unit. Scouts will develop an understanding of group formation and development. They will also have hands-on leadership experiences.

The NYLT course centers on the concepts of:

- What a leader must BE
- What a leader must KNOW, and
- What a leader must DO.

These are taught with a clear focus on how to put these concepts into action. The course will also focus on the EDGE leadership style and SMART goal setting methods.

What Is Its Purpose?

Scouting recognizes that unit leaders have the responsibility of training their own youth leaders. The purpose of National Youth Leadership Training is not to assume that role, but to support it. The objectives of the conference are:

- To enhance the relationship between the participant and their unit leader.
- To give participants a toolbox of leadership skills and help them relate these skills to their unit responsibilities.
- To give participants the opportunity to share ideas and experience with scouts from other units.
- To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the unit program.
- To create an atmosphere where scouts will experience Scouting at its best.

Is the Home Unit Leader Involved?

YES! NYLT is intended to strengthen the relationship between the Youth Leader and their Unit leader.

Who May Attend?

Registered Scouts BSA: At least First Class rank, age 14 or older, who have completed NYLT and who have held a position of leadership, and have their parents and Scoutmaster's approval.

Registered Venturers: At least age 14 but not more than 20, who have Venture Officer Training (Crew Officer Orientation or equivalent), who have completed NYLT and have their parents and advisor's approval.

Scouts will need to bring a current Health Form by June 1, 2020.
