Induction Service Weekend Packing List

- Payment receipt for Induction Service Weekend
- **Completed** Lodge Registration Form
- **Completed** Scouting America Medical Form Parts A and B

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping Pad
- Pillow
- Tent footprint/groundsheet/groundcloth/tarp to sleep on Friday night
- Tent for Saturday night
- Class A Field Uniform (not to be worn until Saturday afternoon; no need for merit badge sash or medals)
- 1 Set of Work Clothes you won't mind getting dirty (recommendations include a long sleeved shirt and long pants)
- 1 Set of Clean Clothes to change into after service project
- 1 Set of Sleepwear
- Sturdy pair of work shoes/boots (must be closed toed shoes)
- Work gloves
- Eye Protection (e.g. glasses, sunglasses, plastic safety glasses)
- Sun protection: hat with a visor/bill/brim, sunscreen, sleeves (if worn with short sleeved shirt)
- Warm jacket/sweatshirt/beanie
- Rain gear - rain jacket, rain pants (check weather report before the weekend)
- Toiletries (showers will not be provided or available; body wipes are suggested)
- Personal First Aid Kit (with tweezers, band aids)
- Reusable water bottle for refilling
- Flashlight/Headlamp

Congratulations on being elected to join the OA! The next step is to participate in an Induction Service Weekend. Please note that you will be sleeping under the stars on Friday night and working on a service project on Saturday. The above list is a suggestion. Please use your camping experience to determine what will help you feel comfortable in the outdoors with wildlife (translation: do not pack smellables, food or snacks). Luxuries, like a camping chair, won't be necessary.
