 - Parent of a Scout
 - Paid Scouting America staff member
 - Volunteer with another nonprofit youth organization
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WHAT TO BRING

DRESS

Scout uniforms are **NOT required**. Class B shirts, BSA shirts, or hats are optional.

Dress comfortably for **indoor and outdoor activities** and changing weather.

DO NOT BRING FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION TO THIS COURSE.

If you are a CCW holder, your personal firearm must remain **secured in your vehicle while in camp**.

This requirement is non-negotiable.

Firearms and ammunition needed for the course will be supplied.

Sworn law enforcement officers should check in with Bill upon entering the property.

Plan to arrive by 7:15 AM at the Firestone Trading Post to park and check in
