Eligibility Requirements

To participate, attendees must be an NRA Range Safety Officer with a minimum of 2 years of range experience and one of the following:

- A registered Scouter or Scouts BSA volunteer
- Paid staff member of Scouts BSA
- Volunteer or staff member of another non-profit youth organization

This course is offered at a reduced cost. All spaces are reserved for individuals who will use their NRA Chief RSO credential to train volunteers with non-profit youth organizations
