5. NO Animais/Pets


Anyone who brings any of the above listed items is subject to removal from camp at their own expense.

Section 3: Rules and Regulations

- 1. No rock throwing of any kind.
- 2. No firearms or ammunition, except what camp provides at range.
- 3. No fireworks of any kind.
- 4. No drugs or alcoholic beverages.
- 5. No smoking: Scouts are prohibited and parents are asked to do it in a designated area only (see ranger).
- 6. Excessive noise is not permitted after 10 PM.
- 7. Closed toe shoes are recommended while at camp, sandals will be permitted at the pool area only.
- 8. Respect other's campsites. Please do not walk through another groups campsite.
- 9. Please do not enter program areas unless supervised by a staff member.
- 10. We highly encourage the buddy system for all activities at camp.
- 11. Tree climbing is not permitted.
- 12. Please do not leave youth unsupervised.
- 13. The cutting of live trees is not permitted. Open fires are **NOT** permitted.

Above all, we ask that you observe the Scout Oath and Law.

Directions to Trask Scout Reservation

Take the 210 Freeway to the Mountain Avenue off ramp in Monrovia. Exit at Mountain, and turn north towards the mountains. Follow Mountain up to Foothill Blvd. Turn left on Foothill and follow it to Canyon Blvd. Turn right on Canyon Blvd. Follow Canyon Blvd up the hill. After crossing Hillcrest Blvd, which has a stop sign, Canyon Blvd will fork. Stay on the right fork. There will be signs indicating Trask Scout Reservation and Monrovia Canyon Park. **YOU WILL SEE A BARRICADE/CLOSURE FOR CANYON PARK. GO AROUND THESE AND CONTINUE TO THE GATE.** There is a combination lock at the entrance, if the gate is closed/locked. The combinations are changed weekly. (<u>YOU MUST RELOCK THE GATE UPON ENTERING</u>.) Please note the combinations above. One more thing – the road into camp is paved and has some tight turns.
