A Short Program Overview

National Youth Leadership Training is a council run intensive six-day course designed to teach key team building and leadership skills that can be used in Scouting, school, and other youth group settings. This course for the youth is led and taught by youth from prior years' courses under the supervision of adult Scoutmasters.

A Month in the Life of a Unit

The NYLT Course models one month of activity for a typical Scouting unit

- The first three full days of course represent the planning stages of Leadership council meetings, Unit meetings, Planning for larger event
- Participants use the full range of BSA resources for planning and conducting meetings that are interesting, lively, and relevant
- Skills and games that they can use when they return to their home units
- Participants put their preparations to the test with an outpost camp symbolizing the big event that culminates a typical unit's activity cycle program

Stages of Team Development

Participants find themselves going through the four stages of team development.

Forming • Storming Norming • Performing

Youth learn and practice how each stage of team development is paired with a style of leading and a style of teaching that works best with the stage.

Presentations are designed to provide a toolbox of effective leadership skills resourced from publications like Stephen Covey "The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People" and Kenneth Blanchard "One Minute Manager ®" series.

<u>Participants MUST attend the Mandatory Pre-Course Orientation on Saturday, October 25, 2025!</u>

<u>This is where course begins! Location: Oso Lake Scout Camp @ 9:00 AM</u>

ALL Participants MUST meet the following requirements:

- Be present **BOTH** weekends of course for the **ENTIRETY**, including the Mandatory Pre-Course Orientation
- Must be a registered member of a Scouting unit.
- Must have a current BSA Health and Medical Record form parts A, B, and C.
- Must have basic camping and outdoor cooking experience.
- Have the Unit Leader's approval to attend NYLT.

Scouts BSA members

- Must be at **least 13** years old.
- Must be First Class Rank by November 7th
- Must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops.
- Complete a week-long Summer Camp

Venturers and Sea Scouts

- must be **between 14-20 years old** (or 13 and have completed eighth grade)
- Must have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Crews or Ships.
- Recommended that they have had at least one year of camping experience.

Application Process:

- 1. Complete all participant application forms. The forms are fillable PDF ready. *No spots will be held with incomplete paperwork*. Wait list priority is based on a first come first received completed paperwork. Email ALL Completed Participant application forms to *Mrs. Quynh-Thi Vidal at ocbsanyltcd@gmail.com*.
 - 1. The Participant Application is complete and signed by the Unit Leader
 - 2. Above requirements are met and verified by the NYLT Registrar
 - 3. Code of Conduct is signed by the Scout and parent (unless the Scout is over 18)

- 1. Medical Form A & B submitted with the application, including a copy of both sides of your health insurance card
- 2. Medical Form C is due PRIOR to October 25, 2025
- 3. Additional Medical Permission Form, if your Scout takes prescription medication.
- 3. Pay the \$395 course fee through https://scoutingevent.com/039-93468
 - 1. If you are applying for a scholarship or troop payment, please contact the Staff Adviser, Peter Jensen at peter.jensen@scouting.org
 - 2. PAYMENT prior to submitting completed forms DOES NOT guarantee your spot.
- 4. Once approved, you will receive a Welcome Letter with more information.

If participant is absent, without prior approval from the Course Director, from the Mandatory Pre-Course Orientation on Oct 25, 2025; their application will be withdrawn, and no refund will be issued. Applicants whose medical form C is not submitted by Oct 25, will be at risk of losing their spot and placed on the waitlist.


