

# WELCOME TO NEWPORT SEA BASE'S

## MOTOR BOATING!



**Thank you for your class registration. We're excited to have you aboard!**

***ALERT: Due to the Covid-19 pandemic we are taking special precautions to ensure the safety of our staff and campers this year. Please be aware that all campers will be required to wear a face mask while on property and must have a backup ready (bring 2 masks). Campers are asked to keep at a safe distance from individuals at all times and will need to bring their own refillable water bottles to camp (we have a refillable station on site). All of our camp staff will be wearing masks and ensuring that campers follow safety measures and protocols. When you arrive our staff will help guide you through our security checkpoints from the comfort of your car. You will be asked to stay in your vehicle for pick up and drop off and we will not have spots for parking. All campers will receive a temperature and health screening before being allowed to enter camp. After the health screening campers will join their counselor and group. We know this is a difficult time and appreciate your help and cooperation. Please also be advised that our office will remain closed to the public. ### **Covid Class Update:**

Each child will be driving a motorboat with at most 2 more children aboard. Masks will be worn during class as this instruction is not considered exercise.

Children will be spread out in the boat as our motorboats are 14-16 ft in length. The motorboating period on the water will be completely open air as well to provide additional safety. Instructors will be close by supervising.

## **Course Description:**

Here are a few items we ask you keep in mind while preparing for class:

- Be sure your camper picks up a syllabus from the instructor.
- Campers should bring a non-perishable sack lunch with them as they may picnic at some point away from the Sea Base.
- There will be a **mandatory swim check** at the beginning of class. **Campers must pass the swim check** to participate in the class.
- Wet suits and goggles are permitted but not provided.
- Sea Base provides life vests for all campers. Life vests **MUST** be worn on docks and boats! Campers should bring a swimsuit, sun block and a towel. Snacks, hats, and a change of clothes are recommended.
- Campers **MUST WEAR CLOSED TOED SHOES AT ALL TIMES**. No sandals, Crocs, or roller shoes are permitted. Shoes will probably get soaked, so water shoes are recommended, but not required.
- Electronics and other valued items should be left at **HOME**.
- Campers have cubbies to put their personal belongings in; Sea Base is not responsible for any damaged or lost items.
- Campers are not permitted to leave the Sea Base without a parent/guardian.
- Campers should label all personal belongings.
- Campers must bring blue cards to class.

**This highly interactive and exploratory class is open to and enjoyable for all youth (girls and boys, ages 11-17), not just Scouts.**

**Note:** Orange County Council, Boy Scouts is dedicated to the safety of all youth who participate in our programs. Consequently, campers must be able to repeat back, in their own words, an accurate understanding of all safety instructions. Campers who are unable or unwilling to do so, may not be eligible to participate. (Youth who are working on their English language skills can decide to bring an interpreter but may still not be eligible to participate.)
