Day Camp Session

Day camp sessions begin with check-in at the roundabout from **7:15am to 8:00am** each morning. Day camp ends each afternoon at **4:00pm**. Please park and walk to the pick-up zone no later than **4:30pm**.

What to Bring

You will need to bring the following items to camp EVERY DAY:

- Refillable water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Hat and Sunglasses
- Snacks
- Backpack
- Face mask and an extra (Per CDC guidelines, face coverings such as face shields are not permitted). *Face masks are only required if state mandate is in effect.
- Sturdy closed toed shoes are always required (unless on pool deck)
- FOR POOL: Goggles, towel, flip flops, swimsuit (no two pieces for females or speedos for males)
– The water slide height requirement is 48 inches.
- Clothing requirements for high ropes, climbing, and zip line: long shorts or pants
- Pen and notebook
- *Please label all belongings

Lunch and Snacks

Lunch is included! Please pack two healthy snacks for all day campers; there will be allocated times for them to have these snacks. Snacks are available for purchase in the Trading Post each day.

Discipline

We expect campers to follow the established code of conduct expressed to campers by his/her counselor on opening day. Any camper following these guidelines will result in appropriate discipline. The counselor will be the first individual to address a camper's behavior problem. If the camper continues the negative behavior, the counselor will notify a member of leadership. If negative behavior continues, the camp director will be notified, and parents will receive a phone call. The camp will contact you if your child is unwilling to change his/her behavior, shows a pattern of disobedience, exhibits violent, disruptive behavior, or is assaulting (i.e. physically or verbally) other campers. A camper who assaults another camper will be dismissed from camp programs with no refund.

Program

Please see the Program Guide to review the activities your camper will be enjoying.

***Program is subject to change due to number of enrollments and weather.**

Certain activities require participants to meet specific guidelines:

- Zip Line
 - Participant weight range: 50lbs-275lbs
- High Ropes
 - Must be 11 years of age or older
 - *Only available for Adventure Camp (11-17 years old)
- Climbing Tower
 - Participant weight range: 30lbs-275lbs
- Pool *
 - Participant height range for the water slide: 48 inches tall (4 ft)
