ASPL(s) must be informed and updated with the information needed to cover for you if you are not available.

Scoutmaster Approval: Scoutmaster must show approval to apply for this position.

- Communicate regularly with youth volunteers to make sure:
 - everyone is informed of camp activities.
 - any problems are worked out smoothly.
 - the camp attendees have a safe and fun experience.
- Assigns duties and responsibilities to other junior leaders and/or youth volunteers; provides follow-up to ensure completion.
- Provides coaching and direction to junior leaders and/or youth volunteers as needed.
- Track and report youth volunteer service hours
