*These should **all** be carried by each patrol*

It's very important that you bring the tools you need to participate in these games. Each patrol should "be prepared" with everything on this list.

Each game station will expect that you will come prepared to show off your skills. We leave it up to you to figure out any other tools or items you may want to drag around but, at a minimum, this list.

Its up to you how to carry and secure all of this gear. Just remember, It will be hard to compete if it looks like a yardsale of gear spread along the trail behind you.

Item Number	Quantity	Description
1	4 / patrol	6' poles suitable for lashing together
2	1 / patrol	Tarp or Blanket suitable for making a litter
3	10' / scout	paracord (Minimum amount. Each scout must have their own)
4	1 / patrol	First-aid Kit
5	1 / patrol	Fire Starter: Can include classic flint and steel, bow drills, or other designs Important Note: matches, lighters, liquid fuels, commercial fire starting products, Greek fire, etc... will NOT be allowed). Fat stick shavings (not whole sticks) will be the only exception to this rule.
6	1 / patrol	Fire starting kit (tinder, kindling, firewood for string burn). See above for restrictions.
7	1 / scout	Compass
8	1 / scout	Flashlight / Headlamp / Lantern
9	1 / scout	Pocketknife
10	1 / scout	Water Bottole
11	Per patrol	Trail Snacks
12	1 / patrol	Sunscreen
13	1 / patrol	Scout Book / Scout Handbook
14	1 / scout	Rain Gear
16	Per patrol	Signalling Device (Not a Smartphone)
17	1 / scout	Extra Clothing
18	1 / patrol	Patrol Flag
