- Have held a position of leadership within the Troop for at least 50% of the previous calendar year.
- Have actively participated in Yolo District events over the previous calendar year.
- Have attained the rank of Star Scout or higher.
- Be a student in "good standing" with their primary academic institution.
- Be involved in at least one extra-curricular activity outside of scouting.
- Demonstrate reverence in his daily life.
