GENERAL INFORMATION:

Participants:

Scouting America Scouts, Venturing Crew or Adults

Teams:

5 person teams – optimum – all 5 scores count
4 person teams are okay – the 5th score will be the lowest total hits of the 4 person team minus 5 hits
6 person teams are okay – the 5 scores will be the top 4 total hits and the lowest total for the 5th score of the 6 totals

Equipment:

ALL participants must have ear and eye protection to participate
Hats and sun screen recommended
Scouts and adults may use their own equipment
12ga, 16ga, 20ga or 28ga
You must supply your own shells – 2 boxes. These CANNOT be “re-loads”

ALL EQUIPMENT MUST BE CHECKED FOR INSPECTION – NO EXCEPTIONS

Scouts and adults may use GEC equipment. Shotgun and shells will be provided. They will be provided when it's your time to shoot. 12ga or 20ga

Schedules:

Shooting schedules will be posted for your convenience. Times may and will vary. Please pay attention to your shooting order and trap box

SHOOTING PROTOCOLS:

- 1 RSO or NRA Instructor at each trap round
- There will be 2 rounds of 25 targets to determine totals
- All scouts will have an adult behind them during their round
- Scouts will be given 1 shell at a time for safety reasons
- Score keepers will be the final say to hit or miss – adults may assist
- If a participant withdraws the remaining targets will be counted as a miss

REFRESHMENTS:

- Bring your own lunch - snacks
- Waters will be available but no snacks or lunch will be provided
- Bring chairs, ice chests, hats, sun screen,

AWARDS:

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards for scouts
- 1st, 2nd place awards for adults
- Top Scout Shooter award
