



Cub Scout Day Camp FAQs

QUESTION	Answer
<p>My pack isn't attending Day Camp. Can my scout still attend?</p>	<p>Yes, absolutely! Your scout can attend without their pack.</p>
<p>Do I have to attend Day Camp with my scout?</p>	<p>If your scout is a Tiger (1st grader), then yes. An adult is required to attend the full camp with the Tiger scout. For older scouts (2nd-5th grade), parents can drop them off and pick them up each day.</p>
<p>My pack isn't attending, only my scout. Do I have to be a Walking Leader?</p>	<p>No. You do not need to be a walking leader if you are only sending 1-2 scouts to Day Camp. If you are sending 3+, please plan on having an adult volunteer to be a Walking Leader. If we have too many single scouts without enough Walking Leaders, we may reach out asking for volunteers.</p>
<p>Will my scout be provided food at Day Camp?</p>	<p>In most cases, no. Our Day Camps do not provide meals for your scout unless specifically stated. Please plan on sending a meal/snack with your scout each day.</p>
<p>My scout has a special need. Can they still attend Day Camp?</p>	<p>Yes! We welcome all scouts. Please let us know ahead of time how we can accommodate your scout. You may want to plan on attending with your scout to provide the support they will need to participate in activities.</p>
<p>My youth isn't registered with a pack. Can they still attend?</p>	<p>Yes! We would love the opportunity to show you how fun Cub Scouts is. Let us know if you need help finding a pack to join!</p>
