Welcome

Welcome to the 2026 Wapiti Merit Badge University. Wapiti MBU is an in-Person event and will not be available online. Interested Wapiti and neighboring District Scouts are invited to sign up for and participate in the event.

Scouts are welcome to sign up for any Merit Badge as they can fit the schedule times. Please make sure you do not sign up for MBs that overlap in sessions.

Merit Badge Program

Merit Badges offered at MBU are listed in the MB Session Schedule. Final MBs will be updated pending meeting the minimum signup requirements. MB sessions are full once the indicated maximum participation number is reached.

Program Information

Class Schedule

Classes are split into 3 blocks of 2 hours with breaks in between and for changing between different classes.

General Information for MBU

Dress Code

This is a Scouting event and Scouting Field Uniform (Class A) should be worn when possible.

Lunch and Snacks

Scouts are responsible for their own lunch and snacks; bring snacks, a sack lunch and water bottle.



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BSA Health Forms

Scouts are responsible to provide a copy of BSA Health Forms (Part A/B1 & B2) at the event check-in from each participant. Forms need to be brought along in paper form and checked in. No electronic copies will be accepted!

Check-In and Check-Out

All Scouts need to check-in at the beginning of the MBU day and need to check-out before leaving MBU after completing their classes!

Check-In and Check-Out is at the MBU registration desk at **Door C7** of the classroom building (see situation map on the last page).

Transportation, Drop-Off & Pick-Up

It is the Scout' responsibility to organize transportation to / from the MBU. The Scouting event starts / ends with the MBU schedule and location.

Scout Code of Conduct

Scouts attending the MBU agree to follow the Scout Oath and Scout Law.

Scouts are responsible to complete all pre-requisites and between-sessions work. Scouts are strongly expected to attend all sessions scheduled for a specific Merit Badge to gain completion of the requirements.

Scouts will connect with each MB Counselor as instructed and will be responsible for completing any not completed or missed requirements to complete a specific MB. Counselors are listed on the MB Session schedule.

Merit Badge Records & Completions

The Merit Badge Session schedule indicates which MBs can be fully completed during the MBU. This assumes that a participating Scout completes all Pre-requisites and between-sessions work.

Merit Badge Counselors will record in-class requirement completions and will provide these records to the MBU Chair at the end of each class. The MBU Chair will enter ALL completions into the event completion logs in Black Pug (the registration website).



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All records will be finalized and entered within two (2) weeks post the 2nd weekend and will be made available through the following means:

- 1) Scouts / Families can access completion records through their registration in Black Pug
- 2) Scouts BSA units will be contacted by the MBU Chair and will have unit records provided for all completions from Scouts in their units. These records equal MB Blue Cards and are the same format as provided at a Scouts BSA summer camp

Electronic (.csv) files for auto import into Scoutbook or TroopWebHost can be provided on request. MBU will NOT provide individual blue cards for completions.

Merit Badge Awards

MBU will NOT award individual completions as part of MBU. The MBU Chair will notify each unit about their Scout' individual advancement and it will be up to the Scouts BSA Troops to recognize and award completions of Merit Badges.

Incomplete Merit Badges

Incomplete Merit Badges are the responsibility of the Scout to connect with a counselor and to arrange for completion of the badge.

Materials

General Materials

Each Scout is responsible for their general materials, such as pens, pencils, spare paper / notebooks, etc.

MB Pamphlets
