Overview:

Cub Scouts, Webelos, and Arrow of Light Scouts are invited to attend the Scout Show on Saturday. We will begin with our opening at 9:00 am. The program areas will run from 9:30 am -4:00 pm. You are welcome to stay for religious services at 6:45 pm and the evening show at 8:00 pm. Please see the attached schedule.

Check In:

Please have everyone check in at the Scout Show Headquarters/Registration at entrance upon arrival. Registration cost is \$10.00 per Cub Scout/Webelos/AOL Scout & Parents. If siblings would like a patch the cost is \$5.00 each to help defray cost.

First Aid:

The Scout Show first aid area will be staffed by medical personal for the weekend for any needs that may arise. The first aid area will be in the small white building next to the blue/white barn. For all life-threatening emergencies please call 911 and then call 860-558-8888 so that we can help direct emergency personal to your location ASAP.

Cub Scout Activity Area:

The Cub Scout Activity Area will be in the ring during the day on Saturday with activities specifically for Cub Scout/Webelos/AOL aged Scouts. There will be a Gaga Pit, obstacle course, Lego Pinewood Derby Track, and many other fun things to do!!

Unit Games/Skills/Activity:

Troops have been asked to setup a games/scout skill demonstration/activity in their campsite to run for the day on Saturday in the morning and afternoon. Please visit these with your Cub Scouts and have fun!!

Restroom Facilities:
