- **Participation Method:** Scouts can read their sacred texts at home with their families, ask their Faith Leader to read at their faith location, or read at their regular meeting place.
- **Event Format:** Includes presentations by Faith Leaders, Scouts reading from Sacred Texts, and time to read privately.
- **Registration:** In-person or via Zoom, with the option to participate in person or remotely.
- **Support:** The event is supported by the Great Falls Council and other local councils, providing resources and guidance for participation.
