The fun begins on Saturday morning. Check-in will be from 9:00 - 9:30 am outside of Sampson Lodge (next to the main parking lot). The program will kick off with an opening ceremony on the parade field at 9:45 am (adjacent to the main parking lot).

Adventure programs will run in Eastern and Western program areas from 10:00 am to 4:45 pm. Start with the section you are assigned to in the morning and cycle through those activities as you wish. After lunch you will switch to the other section. You can travel as a whole Pack or break into smaller groups. Program areas close for lunch from 12:30 - 1:30 pm.

Cars & Carpooling:

Parking is at a premium in camp so please carpool as much as possible.

Please drive only on established camp roads.

ALL vehicles will need to be parked in the main parking lot and remain there until departure.

Getting here:

Rodney Scout Reservation, 400 Rodney Scout Road, North East, MD 21901

GPS Directions to camp may lead to "Boy Scout Rd." Do NOT use this road.

Use "Rodney Scout Road" only.

Check In:

From 9:00 to 9:30 am check-in will occur outside Sampson Lodge, near the main parking lot at Rodney Scout Reservation.

All attendees must be checked in. You will receive a program map for the day and your event patch at check-in.

Program Times & Trail Groups:

Family Adventure Day programs will begin at 10am and run until 4:45pm. The program will kick off with an opening ceremony on the parade field at 9:45 am (adjacent to the main parking lot). There will not be a closing ceremony as participants may leave at various times. The day will be full of adventure and hiking, and some Scouts may tire out faster than others.

Meals:

Please plan on bringing a bag lunch with you for the day. Lunch is from 12:30 – 1:30 on Saturday.

Units camping for the weekend will have the ability to purchase a separate meal plan for Saturday lunch and Saturday dinner, as well as Sunday breakfast.

Day visitors will have the ability to purchase a separate lunch meal for Saturday. Wristbands will be issued for each of the meal plan types.

Please ensure that all your weekend visitors eating with us are registered so that there will be enough food ordered.

Common Courtesy:

Please respect campsites where Units are spending the weekend.

Trash cans will be in each program area.

Remember a Scout is clean!

First Aid:

There will be a Camp Health Officer located on the property for any first aid needs. Please make sure that you have a completed and updated BSA Annual Health & Medical form (Parts A & B) for each person attending.

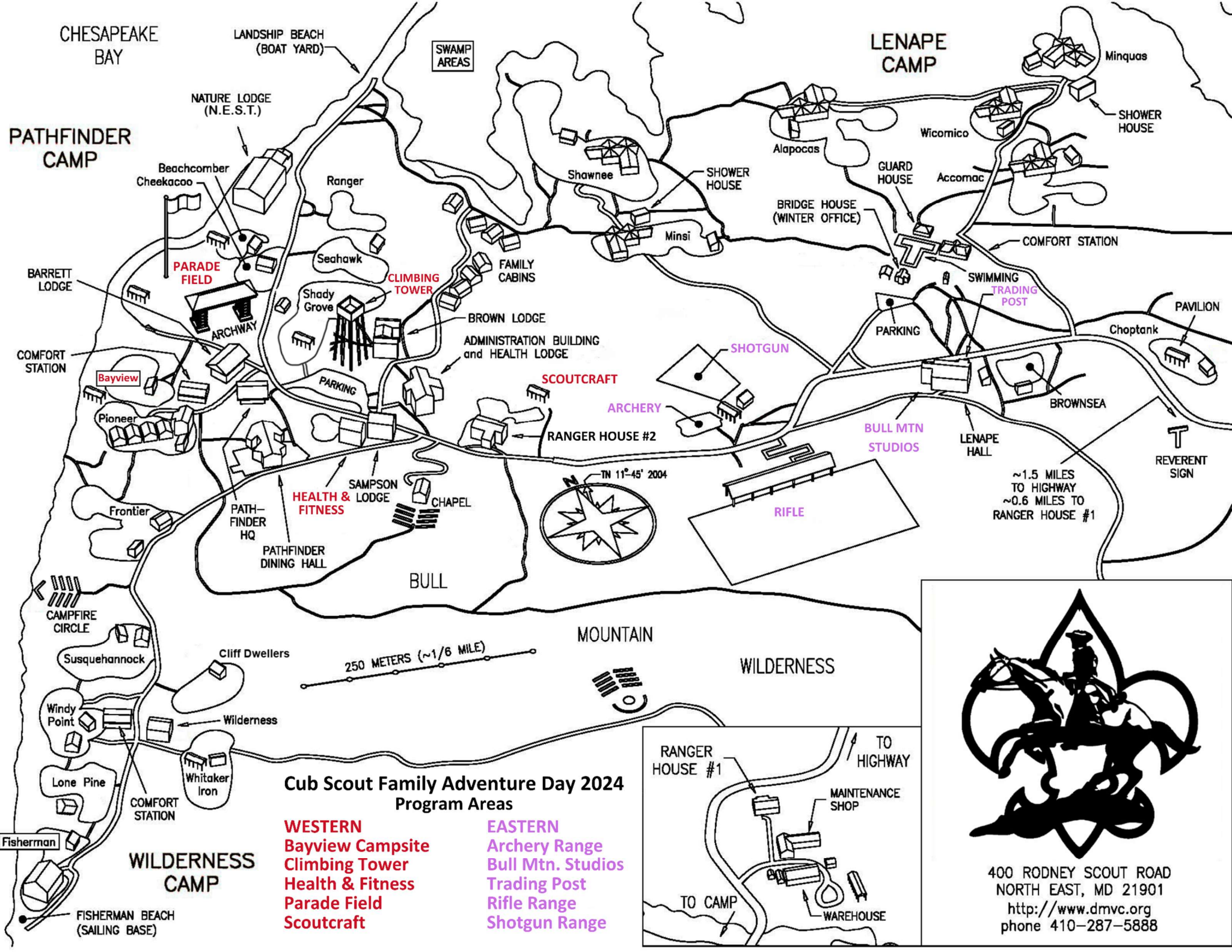

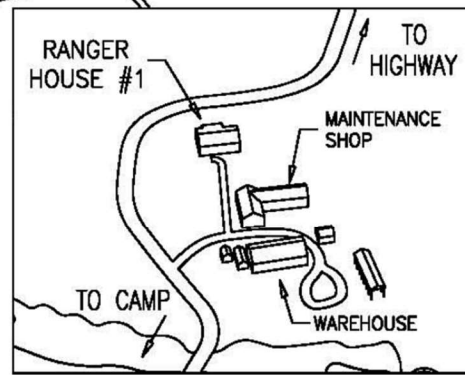
