CAMPER REQUIRED DOCUMENTS CHECKLIST

Registration is a two-part process. The NCAC day camp site (www.gotodaycamp.org) is used to register campers and siblings and pay day camp fees. Once this process is completed, our District day camp requires the following:

- FSK District Camper and Sibling Registration Form
- BSA Annual Health and Medical Record (AHMR) – Parts A and B (3 pages)
- Copy of immunization record or write in dates (month and year) on page 2 of part B of the AHMR.
- Copy (front and back) of the camper's medical insurance card.
- If taking a prescription medication that will be administered at Day Camp, a **doctor's signature is required** on the second page of part B of the AHMR under Allergies/Medications. If taking an emergency medication at camp (such as an epi-pen, rescue inhaler, or diastate), a **doctor's note (can be next to their signature) stating the medication may be carried on their person is required**. Otherwise, all medications will be maintained at First Aid.
- NOTE: All camper registrations must be accompanied by a Den Walker or Staff Registration Packet. If you can serve as a Den Walker for all 5 camp days, email the Program Director at fskcubdaycamp@gmail.com to register as a full week staff member and request the discounted staff child rate, if available. Only 20 staff camperships are made available to each District.

DEN WALKERS AND TIGER ADULT PARTNERS = SAFE SUPERVISION

Who says the campers get to have all the fun? Adults can too! Den Walkers are parents, grandparents, older siblings (18+ years of age), another trusted adult, or Pack member who attends at least 1 full day of camp providing safe supervision just as a chaperone would on a school field trip. Den Walkers are more than welcome to attend 2, 3, 4 or all 5 days. Den Walkers are vital in facilitating the spirit and FUN of our Day Camp program within their Den, capturing camp memories to share, and assisting campers in station activities!

If your **Wolf, Bear, Webelos**, or **Arrow of Light** Scout is attending Day Camp one of the above-mentioned individuals must serve as a Den Walker at least 1 full day of camp per BSA National Camp School guidelines.

Tigers (Scouts entering first grade in the fall) must have an Adult Partner accompanying them each day of camp; this does not have to be the same adult every day per BSA National guidelines.

FSK DISTRICT CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP - CODE OF CONDUCT

Campers, parents, den walkers, and staff members are expected to uphold the values of the Scout Oath and Law.

1. The Buddy System will be always in effect. No camper should ever go anywhere in camp without his or her buddy.
2. There will be no running at camp, except in designated areas for games and sports.
3. Rocks and sticks are to remain on the ground – a stick or rock that is not picked up or kicked is less likely to be a danger to another camper or oneself.
4. Knives and flammable objects are not permitted except for use by camp staff for program purposes ONLY.
5. Smoking or vaping is PROHIBITED; this includes parking areas and bathrooms.
6. The use of alcohol or illegal substances at camp is PROHIBITED. If anyone arrives to camp under the influence, appropriate authorities or medical personnel will be contacted by the Camp Director for their and our members safety.
7. ANY cases of actual or suspected abuse, even slight, must be reported to the Camp Director immediately.
8. No abusive or inappropriate language should ever be directed towards a camper, staff member, or parent volunteer. Inappropriate language includes the phrase “shut up.”
9. Parents/Guardians WILL be held monetarily responsible for any damages willfully caused by their Camper(s) to camp or facility property, including the portable toilets.
10. The Camp Director reserves the right to remove any person(s) who presents a danger to themselves or others in attendance.

Discipline at Camp: Following BSA Youth Protection Guidelines, no Scout will be disciplined in a public forum with others immediately present. Any member of camp not upholding the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law will be given a “*3 strikes, you’re out!*” ruling:

Strike #1: Verbal warning issued with acknowledgement of what value was not being upheld

Strike #2: Time out observed in the Administrative Area followed by a discussion with the Camp Director of the importance of upholding the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law. The Camp Director may seek parent/guardian support in their discussion at the end of the camp day.

Strike #3: Those who continue to NOT uphold the values of the Scout Oath and Scout Law, Scout, or adult, at camp (i.e., disrespectful, out of control, or harmful behavior), will be requested to leave or have their parents/guardian called for IMMEDIATE pick up.

Fighting of any kind will NOT be tolerated and will result in the immediate dismissal from camp.

CARPOOLING

For camper safety, any parent or guardian utilizing a carpool for pick up from camp MUST submit the signed carpool form below authorizing their camper to be released to a specified list of authorized persons. These individuals may be required to present a photo ID verifying they are in fact the listed authorized pick-up person. If the individual’s name is not listed on the carpool slip, neither the camper’s Den Walker nor the administrative staff will release the camper.

All spent casings or hulls may be disposed of by placing them in any blue trash receptacle located throughout the property.
