Enhancing Service to Units

Enhancing Service to Units is tailored for DCs and ADCs, and covers how the commissioner service to units concept is only rarely being completed. Issues identified by the commissioners are entered into Commissioner Tools, but those issues rarely get to the Key 3 or district committee. In turn, those units with identified issues rarely get the help they need. The good news is that administrative commissioners can use existing reports, use some elbow grease, match unit issues with experts, and come up with a report that can be easily taken to the Key 3 and district committee. In turn, this amended process should get help to those units in need and complete the commissioner service to units process. Select ACCs could be interested in this class as well.
