Montgomery College Merit Badge College

Welcome and thank you for registering for the Montgomery College merit badge college at the Rockville Campus.

The day will begin at 8am with check in in the Gymnasium (marked PE on the map). There will be a welcome session and courses will begin promptly at 9am. Please No High Heals on the gym floor.

Parents are welcome to drop scouts off or spend the day, parents are expected to be observers and respectful of the instructors. Parents who have current YPT are welcome to register to staff the event. There are various positions, and you will receive a patch for your help.

All merit badge councilors are registered and trained, there are also additional adults assigned to each class to support YPT requirements as well as to assist with the badges administration.

Be sure to check the Prerequsites and notes. This is a uniformed event and Scouts and Scouters are expected to arrive in uniform. Some Merit badges may cause the scouts to get dirty. If this is the case it will be in the notes in this guide, please bring an appropriate change of clothes. The expectation is that if a scout completes the prerequisites and is an active participant in the class, they will complete the merit badge.
