Ordeal Candidate Checklist

Wear To Your Ordeal: Arrive in a BSA Field Uniform (aka Class A)

These items should be packed in a separate bag from the rest of your gear and be easily carried:
Waterproof Ground Cloth/Tarp (Big enough to cover over and under Scout, size 8 x 10 recommended)
Sleeping Bag and Ground Pad
Flashlight
Insect Repellent & Sunscreen
Pocket sized, personal hand sanitizer
Face mask (no bandana or buff types permitted)
Water Bottle (already filled at home)
Your remaining gear should include the following:
BSA Medical Form (Parts A and B required)
Medications (if applicable) - Inform those in charge at check-in if you have prescribed medications.
Backpack (or duffle bag for carrying your gear)
Wet Weather Gear
Basic Toiletries
Work Clothes (Some work projects may involve work that will potentially stain/soil your clothing. Bring clothes that you
don't mind getting dirty or paint on. You may also encounter poison ivy, so consider wearing a long-sleeve shirt and pants
for your work clothing. Bring a spare change of work clothes in a plastic bag in case you need to change during the day.)
Sturdy boots or work shoes (no open toed shoes allowed)
Work Gloves
Baseball Hat (or other type of hat with a brim)
Filled, one (1) gallon jug of drinking water. Label the jug with your name.
Sharpened Pocket Knife (no fixed blade knives permitted)
Small Tent (with ground tarp)
Other clothing appropriate for the weather and time of year. Pack for the season; be prepared
Anvil loppers, hand pruners, bow saw, rake or shovel (labeled with Scout's last name)
Camp Chair
DO NOT BRING electronic devices such as iPads, ear buds, radios or handheld games. You may be asked to check-in your cell phone or to lock it in your vehicle.
DO NOT BRING any snacks or food items.

REMEMBER: All clothing should be appropriate for the outdoors and time of year. You should pack for the season; be prepared!
