Campsite Evaluation Criteria

CAMPSITE GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Tents pitched by patrol: tents for each patrol must be grouped together with entrances facing each other
- Campsite neat and orderly: Areas between tents free of tripping hazards/existing hazards identified
- Tent flaps up/down according to weather conditions: *up if weather is warm and fair and down if cool or rainy*
- Menu for all meals posted: *self-explanatory*
- Duty Roster posted: all meals included; cooking and cleanup

HEALTH, SAFETY, AND SANITATION

- First aid kit easily seen: present and readily accessible
- Patrol Gear Stowed: in boxes or other containers
- Cooking Fuels properly stored: *fuel properly labeled, stored away from stove and ignition sources*
- Wood tools properly stored: *safety first*
- Cooking area clean: no litter, food spills cleaned up, etc.
- Dishes washed and put away: drying on racks, in air mesh bags, or stored properly
- Garbage securely stored: area free of litter, trash bags/cans provided & being used
- Fire plan posted: steps in the event of fire, fire watch required
- Fire attended or out, cold to touch: self-explanatory
- Fire located in proper area: in a fire ring, barbeque pit, etc.
- Fire Buckets: present near fire ring
- Food properly stored: protected from animals, spoilage, contamination, etc.
- Toilet Area Clean: free of trash and spills

SCOUT SPIRIT

- Patrol independence: Scouts operating independently from Adult Leaders
- Patrol training: Are the Scouts all 14 and younger
- Entryway with patrol identification: patrol name and symbol visible
- Camp Gadget Pioneering Project: useful camp gadget (Extra Credit)
- American Flag (Extra Credit)
- Patrol Axe Yard (Extra Credit)
- Troop Flag (Extra Credit)
