Below are the requirements for the merit badge: Please note that the highlighted items should be completed BEFORE Scouts arrive for the merit badge

2017 Occoquan Merit Badge Day – Electricity Merit Badge Preparation

- 1. (Study & Practice) Demonstrate that you know how to respond to electrical emergencies by doing the following:
- a. Show how to rescue a person touching a live wire in the home.
- b. Show how to render first aid to a person who is unconscious from electrical shock.
- c. Show how to treat an electrical burn.
- d. Explain what to do in an electrical storm.
- e. Explain what to do in the event of an electrical fire.
- 2. (MAKE A CHECK LIST FROM THE PAMPHLET and BRING IN COMPLETED CHECKLIST Badge will not be signed off without this requirement!) Complete an electrical home safety inspection of your home,

using the checklist found in this pamphlet or one approved by your counselor. Discuss what you find with your counselor.

- 3. (STUDY only. WILL DO DOING MERIT BADGE DAY) Make a simple electromagnet and use it to show magnetic attraction and repulsion. -
- 4. (STUDY) Explain the difference between direct current and alternating current.
- 5. **(STUDY Scouts will make the drawing during merit badge Day)** Make a simple drawing to show how a battery and an electric bell work.
- 6. (STUDY and <u>Take a photo</u> of the breaker panel in your home and print out and bring to session.

 Badge will not be signed off without this requirement!) Explain why a fuse blows or a circuit breaker trips. Tell how to find a blown fuse or tripped circuit breaker in your home. Show how to safely reset the circuit breaker.
- 7.(STUDY) Explain what overloading an electric circuit means. Tell what you have done to make sure your home circuits are not overloaded.
- 8. . (BRING IN COMPLETED DIAGRAM Badge will not be signed off without this requirement!) Make a floor plan wiring diagram of the lights, switches, and outlets for a room in your home. Show which fuse or circuit breaker protects each one.
- 9. Do the following:
- a. (STUDY and <u>Take a photo</u> of the electric meter in your home and print out and bring to session. <u>Bring in a copy of your electric bill</u>.) Read an electric meter and, using your family's electric bill, determine the energy cost from the meter readings.
- b. (STUDY) Discuss with your counselor five ways in which your family can conserve energy.
- 10. **(STUDY)** Explain the following electrical terms: volt, ampere, watt, ohm, resistance, potential difference, rectifier, rheostat, conductor, ground, circuit, and short circuit.
- 11. (STUDY only. We WILL DO DOING a. and b. during MERIT BADGE DAY and the counselor will bring the materials for this.) Do any TWO of the following:
- a. Connect a buzzer, bell, or light with a battery. Have a key or switch in the line.
- b. Make and run a simple electric motor (not from a kit).
- c. Build a simple rheostat. Show that it works.
- d. Build a single-pole, double-throw switch. Show that it works.
- e. Hook a model electric train layout to a house circuit. Tell how it works.
