Woodwork Merit Badge Shop Session Event Plan	
Event Description	This session will be held in Michael's Woodshop and is designed to allow Scouts to work on projects to meet Requirements 4, 5 and 6 of the merit badge. Scouts will have supervised access to shop tools and equipment in accordance with the Tool Usage Rules.
Date/Time	See schedule posted on the Camp Snyder website
Shop Steward(s)	Two Shop Stewards will be on hand to supervise tool use, enforce safety rules and to offer guidance and instruction as needed.
Participant Age	Scouts BSA
Max # of Participants	4 per session
Prerequisites	Scouts must have completed Requirement 1 of the Woodwork Merit Badge prior to attending this session.
Materials Needed	General shop supplies such as sandpaper, wood glue, finish nails and wood screws are provided. Scouts must arrive with their project plans, lumber and any hardware needed to complete their project(s). Scouts must bring their blue cards with them to the session.

Woodwork Merit Badge Shop Session Activity Plan

Step	Description	Notes
1	A safety briefing will be given at the start of each session.	
2	Scouts will be given work space and will have access to tools needed for laying out their projects.	
3	Scouts need to ask for permission and wait for approval, instruction and supervision for the use of all tools and equipment.	The Tools Usage Rules are posted in the shop and these will be followed at all times.
4	The final 10 minutes of each session will be set aside for shop clean up. All tools will be returned to their proper location and the shop will be swept and vacuumed as needed.	

NOTE: Due to the drying time and other factors, Scouts will not be permitted to apply finishes to their projects during this session. Scouts are expected to paint/finish their projects at home.
