PREMIER "AIR CONDITIONED ROOMS":

- Includes bunk beds, mattresses, electrical
- Sleeps: 4 per room (1-2 rooms per site)

PREMIER "AIR CONDITIONED CABINS":

- Includes bunk beds, mattresses, electrical
- Sleeps: 2-6 per cabin (5 available)

PREMIER "AIR CONDITIONED BUNKHOUSES":

- Includes bunk beds, mattresses, electrical
- 1 common room with fridge, microwave, TV
- 3 sleeping rooms per bunk house
- Sleeps: 16-24 per bunkhouse (3 available)

PREMIUM "ADIRONDACK- SCREENED CABINS":

- Includes bunk beds, fan, mattresses, electrical
- 2 room shelter option available/4 per room (mattresses)
- Sleeps: 6-10 per cabin (5 cabins per site)

DELUXE "TWO PERSON CANVAS TENTS/COTS":

- Canvas tents on platforms featuring two cots
- 2 room shelter included with fans, lights, electrical
- Sleeps: 2-30 per site/4 per room (no mattresses)

STANDARD "OPEN SITE":

- Open space to set up a unit or personal tents
- 2 room shelter included with fans, lights, electrical
- Sleeps: 40 per site/4 per room (no mattresses)

PRIMITIVE CAMPING:

- Large open space to fit groups of 10-500
- Area for activities, camping and parking
- 2 Restrooms with showers, toilets, sinks, spigot

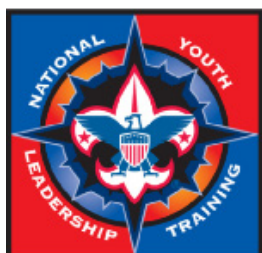

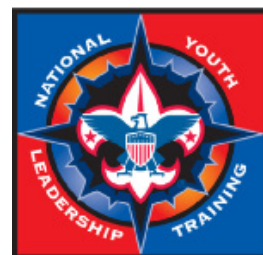
