- Obey all La-No-Che Camp Rules
- ➤ Always follow the Scout Oath and Law
- > Always follow the buddy system including when after dark
- > Always follow safe Scouting Guidelines
- > Follow Chain of Command
  - Concerns/problems should be reported to your PL (first)→ ASPL → SPL
- > Stay in assigned tent, changes must be approved by SM (in advance)
- > Follow assigned schedule for classes / any changes must go thru SM
- ➤ Hike to all Camp Flags together from Campsite (Breakfast and Dinner)
- US Flag raising/lowering in campsite prior to hiking to meals
- > Patrols are to comply with duty roster of PROVO Camp as established by PLC
- > Tents to be clean and orderly each day as established by PLC
- Personal space and personal property are always to be respected
- By 11:00 (camp lights out) you are expected to be in your assigned tent
- No open flames in any tents at any time, knives are to be used properly
- > Follow any additional rules or guidelines established by your PLC
- Provo Scouts must be in campsite by 9:30 PM
- Provo Scouts are required to attend any opening and closing shows as a unit.
