Camp La-No-Che Aquatics Programs provide 4 hours of instruction and fun for these 6 programs. Scouting requires all programs be supervised by a lifeguard (or other qualified supervision*) at a ratio of 1 lifeguard for every 10 participants. Camp provides 2 lifeguards with every aquatics program and adds one per 10 participants over 20.

*Groups may provide their own additional qualified supervision for aquatics programs. If needed beyond the 2 required lifeguards that are hired by Camp La-No-Che. "Qualified Supervision" includes youth/adults (15 yrs or older) with current Lifeguard training, proof of valid certification required.

AQUATICS PROGRAMS (4 HR)
