

CAMPING & DAY TRIPS

CURATED PROGRAMS

Offering a selection of curated programs, Camp La-No-Che has built experiences to offer a taste of several areas throughout your stay. All run approximately 8 hours and include a bagged lunch, upgrade to a hot lunch for an additional fee. Each curated program may have age restrictions, weight requirements, clothing needs, and group min/maximums, please consult the information contained in this document and online before booking your experience.

CURATED PROGRAMS

(20 person minimum to register)

EXPLORER: (ANY AGE)

Cost \$40 per person (Deposit- \$50)

Experience a half-day of learning basic outdoor/nature skills, and a half-day at our aquatics experience.

RANGER: (ANY AGE)

Cost \$70 per person (Deposit- \$50)

Experience a half-day of climbing in the morning, then choose either a shooting sports program (Archery/BBs/Rifle) or aquatics experience in the afternoon.

ADVENTURER: (AGE 11 & UP)

Cost \$100 per person (Deposit- \$50)

Get a half-day of team building challenges, facilitated by trained staff, then take to the air on our High Ropes Static Course, Rappel Tower and a 1300 ft zip line.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS

(20 person minimum to register)

BIG STUMP "MUD" HIKE (AGE 11 & UP):

Cost \$5 per person (Deposit- \$25)

A one-of-a-kind experience located only at Camp La-No-Che! Journey deep into the backwoods and experience a hike where the goal is get "down and dirty"! You will make it home. However your clothes and shoes likely will not, so please plan accordingly. This hike is guided by an experienced Camp La-No-Che Staff Member, and team work is a requirement!

GUIDED TRAIL HIKE (AGE 6 & UP):

Cost \$5 per person (Deposit- \$25)

Journey the trails of Camp La-No-Che, and learn the history of camp from a Camp La-No-Che Staff Member. Lots of trails to choose from throughout the property, visit sulfur springs, adventure camp, and more! Camp has been home to Scouts for going on 75 years, but folks where here long before. Lots to learn, not mention the animals and ecosystem they call home!

ADVENTURE CAMP PROGRAMS

There is no better place to experience adventure than Camp La-No-Che. Featuring challenging activities, ranging from team building programs to challenge courses. Not to mention 2 towers taking campers over 50-feet into the air, and a 1600 ft zip line! All programs have policies and procedures in order to maintain safe operation. Please follow carefully rules regarding age, and weight.

ADVENTURE TOWER EXPERIENCE (4 HR)

Cost \$900 flat rate for groups 1-12, & \$75 for each additional person (Deposit- \$50)

A complete Adventure Camp Experience featuring all 3 fantastic events, conquer your fears and fly through the air at Camp La-No-Che!

RAPPELLING (AGE 11 & UP):

Challenge yourself as you ascend over 40 ft into the air, and test your courage as you lean over the edge of the biggest tower in camp.

STATIC CHALLENGE COURSE (AGE 11 & UP):

Featuring three high level obstacle courses. Challenge yourself and your group members to conquer the Adventure Tower.

ZIP LINE (AGES 11 & UP, 75 - 250LB):

Feel the wind in your face and adrenaline within your body as you step off a platform 40 ft in the air and sail 1300 ft through the air.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS:

(12 person minimum, ATV is 6)

ATV ASI PROGRAM (AGES 16 & UP):

Cost \$75 per person, 8 hour minimum, (Deposit- \$25)

An introduction to the adventures of riding ATVs in our ATV Safety Institute Course.

BIKE RENTAL (AGES 11 & UP):

Cost \$10 per person, 4 hour session, (Deposit- \$25)

Enjoy a trail ride through the edge of the Ocala National Forest.

CLIMBING (AGES 11 & UP):

Cost \$600 flat rate for groups 1-12, & \$50 for each additional person (Deposit- \$50)

Choose which climbing program is right for you fun for beginners and veterans, 3 walls to choose from!

COPE PROGRAM/T-Shirt (AGES 14 & UP):

Cost \$60 per person, 8 hour minimum, (Deposit- \$25)

Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience offers team building & challenge programs to build strong teams.

TEAM BUILDING (AGES 11 & UP):

Cost \$20 per person, 4 hour session, (Deposit- \$25)

Build a team dynamic through challenging low ropes and games focused on communication, problem solving, & overcoming barriers.

ZIP LINE-1300FT (AGES 11 & UP, 75-250lb):

Cost \$40 per person, 2 hour session, (Deposit- \$25)

Kick your adventure camp experience to the next level by completing our 1300ft zip line.

AQUATICS PROGRAMS

Camp La-No-Che Aquatics Programs provide 4 hours of instruction and fun for these 6 programs. The BSA requires all programs be supervised by a lifeguard (or other qualified supervision*) at a ratio of 1 lifeguard for every 10 participants. Camp provides 2 lifeguards with every aquatics program and adds one per 10 participants over 20.

*Groups may provide their own additional qualified supervision for aquatics programs. If needed beyond the 2 required lifeguards that are hired by Camp La-No-Che. "Qualified Supervision" includes youth/adults (15 yrs or older) with current BSA/Red Cross Lifeguard training, proof of valid certification required.

AQUATICS PROGRAMS (4 HR)

(Cost \$300 flat rate for groups 1-20)

(\$15 for each additional person, Deposit- \$100)

CANOES/KAYAKS/ROWBOATS/PADDLE BOARDS: (AGE 11 & UP, EXCEPT FOR CANOEING WITH ADULT)

Explore Lake Norris in your own personal paddle craft, travel the waterway exploring nature and our camp ecosystem. (swim test required)

SWIMMING AT THE AQUATICS CENTER (ANY AGE):

- Covered seating area with 6 picnic tables
- Deep well dive pool, 12 ft
- Slide pool, zero degree entry, 4ft
- 160 swimmer max

CAMP LA-NO-CHE AQUATICS EXPERIENCES

AQUATICS 1/2 DAY EXPERIENCE:

Cost \$300 flat rate for groups 1-20, for 4 hrs

\$15 for each additional person, Deposit- \$50

Open to all groups big or small. Reserve both pools and lake for the use of your group for a half-day.

POOL SIDE MOVIE EXPERIENCE:

Cost \$300 flat rate for groups 1-20, for 3 hours

\$15 for each additional person, Deposit- \$50

Open to all groups big or small. Reserve the slide pool and enjoy a pool side movie.

SHOOTING SPORTS PROGRAMS

Scouts go camping for the MEMORIES, and there is no better place to make those memories than Camp La-No-Che. Featuring a wide range of shooting sports activities for youth of all ages. Our facilities are designed to offer a safe, accessible experience for all ability levels, with the guidance of certified range safety personnel.

PROGRAMS BY THE HOUR

(Min: 6; Max: 18*)

ARCHERY (ANY AGE):

Open to all ages, kid to adult! Whether this is your first time holding a bow or your a veteran archer our staff will work with you to make your experience memorable.

- Group Shoot (1hr): \$4 per person, (Deposit- \$25)

BB-GUN (AGE 7 & UP):

This is an opportunity to learn basic gun safety, and experience what its like to aim down the sights and hit the target.

(Per National BSA policy, Lion Cubs/KG may not shoot BB Guns)

- Group Shoot (1 hr): \$4 per person, (Deposit- \$25)

SLINGSHOT (AGE 6 & UP):

Journey back to a time long ago, and test you aim at targets of varying difficulty. A fun activity to test who has the best shot?

- Group Shoot (1 hr): \$4 per person, (Deposit- \$25)

PROGRAMS BY THE ROUND

(Min: 6; Max: 18*)

RIFLE (AGE 11 & UP):

This is an opportunity to take target shooting to the next level. Experience shooting a .22 rifle! Can you shoot 5 shots under a dime?

- Round: \$5.00 per 25 shots, (Deposit- \$25)

SHOTGUN (AGE 11 & UP):

This advanced shooting sport program incorporates the use of 12 and 20 gauge shotguns. Do you have a keen eye to track the clays as they fly through the air? Practice makes perfect!

- Round: \$10.00 per 5 shells, (Deposit- \$25)

BLACK POWDER (AGE 11 & UP):

This advanced shooting sport program takes you back to a time long ago. Learn how our colonial settlers hunted and won our independence through the shooting of black powder rifles.

- Round: \$4 per 2 shots, (Deposit- \$25)

PACKAGE PRICING

Groups planning a half-day or full-day of range activities may choose to book the ranges for a "package price". Extended shooting packages may make it possible for Scouts to begin work toward Merit Badges or Groups to enjoy a day on the range. Bookings made by the hour. Min/Max group size based on through-put in one hour.
