SAFETY RULES

- <u>The Buddy System must be followed always while at camp. Buddy Pairs whenever</u> <u>possible must be same gender, tripples are allowed when not possible.</u>
- One fire is permitted per site. <u>Do not</u> use pine cones, pine needles, Spanish moss, kerosene, or gasoline in the fire. While burning, the fire must be attended at all times.
- No flames or fires of any kind are permitted in tents.
- Stick, roll-on, or pump insect repellent and deodorant is preferred.
- Wear closed toed shoes <u>at all times.</u> Open toed shoes, flip flops, or sandals may be used between campsite and latrines only.
- Riding on the tailgate of a car or in the back of a pickup truck is <u>prohibited</u> at all times while in Scouts, BSA.
- Park all vehicles in the main camp parking lot unless you have a parking pass designating your permission to be in camp.
- Use extension cords only inside buildings.
- Camp La-No-Che discourages camouflage clothing due to safety.
- Use of alcoholic beverages and controlled substances are <u>not permitted</u>. Any individual or group violating this rule must leave the facility.
- No fireworks or privately owned firearms are permitted on Scouting AmericaProperty.
- All bicycle riders <u>must</u> wear safety helmets.
- Water filling Stations are located throughout camp and it is highly encouraged to carry your own <u>filled water bottle</u>. Drink Plenty of Water!

LIGHTNING ALARM PLAN OF ACTION

Florida is the lightning capital of the world and represents a hazard that all should be made keenly aware. Please follow Camp Staff instructions during inclement weather. The levels used at camp based on potential danger in the area are listed below:

- GREEN (No storms detected in the area)
- YELLOW (Approaching storms detected in the area)
- RED (Storms in area, seek shelter immediately)

The only appropriate shelters during a RED designation are walled structures. Including:

- Dining Hall, Campsite Activity Shelter, Bunk Houses, Rotary Lodge

CAMP WIDE EMERGENCY

In the event there is a camp wide emergency a wailing (air raid) siren will sound. If you hear this siren, please proceed to the following: report to Seneff Plaza Flag Pole. Line up with your unit, take roll call, have your SPL report to the Camp Commissioner that your unit is accounted for, and wait for further instructions from the Camp Staff. Every-one, youth and adults, must report to the designated area during a camp wide emergency alarm unless instructed otherwise by the camp staff. The entire camp will have an opportunity to practice these procedures during your stay at camp.
