QUALIFICATIONS: YOU can participate in this exciting *leadership* training experience if you:

- 1. are a **current-registered adult Scouter**, active in a Pack, Troop, Venturing Crew, District or Council.
- 2. have **completed** *New Leader Essentials* & *Position Specific Training* for your position. Note: *Outdoor Leader Skills* is required for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters.
- **3.** submit an **application** with a \$50 deposit, to reserve your place on course.
- **4.** submit a completed *BSA Medical Form*, parts A, B and C (must have been completed no earlier than September 1, 2018).

<u>COST</u>: *The* **course fee** of \$250, which may be paid in *installments*, with the remaining balance being paid **no later** than **August 13, 2019**. This coarse fee covers all training materials, food, lodging and supplemental uniform items. Additional costs will be the responsibility of the participant (personal gear and uniforms).

REFUNDS: Fees (minus \$50.00 deposit) will be refunded, if you are unable to attend, provided you notify the course director by **August 13, 2019**. **Space is limited** ... **Register early!** In the event the application is <u>not</u> accepted, *total* fees will be refunded. Candidates will be accepted on a *first-come-first-served basis*, until the course reaches maximum capacity. *Alternates* will be notified and placed on a *stand-by* list ... if "*stand by*" is requested.

SCHOLARSHIPS: Opportunities may exist for scholarships. Contact the course director if you need assistance in locating these opportunities.

WOOD BADGE

WOOD BADGE is an *advanced* training in *leadership* development. The **WOOD BADGE** program consists of two parts:

- 1. *Practical* training *learning/practicing* the *leadership* material taught during the six days on course;
- 2. *Application applying* those *leadership* skills to your Scouting position over the following 18 months, "working your ticket."

WOOD BADGE training does NOT cover outdoor skills. The course draws from up-to-date *leadership* models used by corporate America, academic circles, and successful outdoor leadership organizations throughout the country. The course sessions include *Team Development*, *Diversity* training, and *Project Management*, to mention a few. This combination of hands-on, direct experience and application of *leadership* skills is incredibly effective. WOOD BADGE has served as a source of training and inspiration for thousands of Scouters who, in turn, have affected the lives of millions of Scouting's youth. Participants discover ways to not only use the *leadership* skills in their Scouting positions but, also, to better their personal lives, as well.

For six days, you will live, learn, and work with other Scouters, while being exposed to the *leadership* skills applicable to the development of the Scouting program. Through the **WOOD BADGE** experience, you will develop a deeper, more practical understanding of *leadership* skills. It can help to clarify what you *want to accomplish* in your Scouting role, and learn ways to apply your skills in your Pack, Troop, Crew, District, and/or Council.

Subsequently, you will have the opportunity to practice these *leadership* skills to help make you more productive in your Scouting role, as you complete your **WOOD BADGE** "*ticket*." All the while enjoying the fellowship, assistance, and mentorship of those who have already completed their "ticket." **WOOD BADGE** not only provides the opportunity to learn and practice *leadership* skills, it also offers the potential to develop and build a network of support that can assist you throughout your scouting career.
