

Check In will be from 4 - 9pm on Friday and we will be collecting our Covid Screening form at that time. You now have the option use either the paper option or the online submission of the pre-screening form that will be asked for at check in. **Please be sure that you complete 1 of these 2 options prior to arrival at camp.**

A few things to know:

- 1. Anyone who does not meet the Pre-Screening requirements will not be allowed to enter camp.** This includes anyone who has traveled to camp in the same vehicle. If anyone is not feeling well or has a fever, please DO NOT bring them to camp.
 - 2. Early Arrival on Friday with prior approval only.** Early arrivals that have not been pre-approved will cause the road to back up as people wait for check in to open and will cause further challenges or delays.
 - 3. Check in begins on Friday at 4pm and will end at 9pm.** You will not be able to enter camp after 9pm on Friday so please plan accordingly. This also means that if you are only dropping off you will also need to plan to exit camp by 9pm on Friday.
 - 4. Check in will resume on Saturday at 7:30am.** Opening Flag is at **8:15am** and activities begin at **8:30am.**
 - 5. Each campsite has a box with schedules, passports, meal tickets & patches for participants.** If you pre-ordered T-shirts, it will be in a bag either next to or in this box along with a list of those who purchased. Please take your t-shirt(s) and check your name off the list.
 - 6. If you Pre-Ordered Pumpkins or an Icee on the Human Hamster Wheel,** you will not need a ticket for those this year as we will have a list at the station and will check your name on that list.
 - 7. You may purchase a pumpkin and/or an Icee the day of however,** we cannot guarantee availability. You may also bring your own pumpkin.
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8. **The Friday night movie will begin at 7:00pm at the COUNCIL RING down by the lake.** Limited concessions will be available for purchase.
 9. **An informational parent/leader meeting will immediately follow the movie** at the COUNCIL RING at approx 8:30pm. Please ensure that 2 adults per campsite attend this meeting.
 10. **Campsite capacity is limited, and you very likely will be sharing with another unit.** If your group is large, you may be in two adjacent campsites. If your group is small, you will likely have others from your district/geographical area in the campsite with you. Please welcome your campmates and help each other if need be.
 11. **CONTESTS:** Judging for pumpkins and decorations will occur on Saturday night. Ribbons will be given out at the Closing Ceremony on Sunday immediately following breakfast at the Seneff Plaza.
 1. **Pumpkin Carving:** If you pre-purchased a pumpkin during registration, you may pick it up at the pumpkin patch on Saturday. You may also bring your own pumpkin to carve and enter into the contest. Please leave your decorated/carved pumpkin on the hearth in the Dining Hall.
 2. **Campsite Decoration:** Decorate your campsite and compete for a ribbon for your pack flag.
 12. **Please bring your own tents, camping gear and cooking gear.** Campsites DO NOT have grills. As an alternative, you may purchase meals during the registration process.
 13. **PLEASE NOTE:** Wildlife, mosquitoes and ticks are commonplace in the outdoors and Camp La-No-Che is no exception. Please observe wildlife from a distance and keep all food, candy, soda, etc. out of your tent and secured tightly. Use a bug repellent that contains DEET as it will keep the mosquitoes away and even help with ticks. Avoid walking through or playing in high grass areas as well as walking in the woods off existing trails as this will increase your chances ticks.
 14. **Masks are required whenever you are in a building (including the activity shelters) and whenever social distancing is not possible** – even if you are outside. Please be sure that everyone in your group has a mask to wear.
 15. **This year's schedule is a split block style/open schedule.** Participants will be moving through the program areas as a group in a cohort, aka a patrol.
 16. **Earn your Bobcat Badge!** The Bobcat Badge is the first badge that a cub scout earns. Classes will be held in the dining hall at 8:30am, 9:30am, 10:30am and 11:30am. Please come to the class time of your choosing.
 17. **Judging for pumpkins and decorations will** occur on Saturday night. Ribbons will be given out at the Sunday Closing Flag immediately following breakfast.
 18. **The Haunted House, & Haunted Trail are returning in 2021! Plus, we have a Haunted Cemetery as part of the evening activities.** Scouts are encouraged to bring costumes for the evening activities.
 19. **Trick or Treating from Campsite to Campsite** is a Cub Halloween tradition. Please bring some candy to share with all of the lil' ghosts and ghouls.



20. A **Scout's Own Service** will be held on Sunday morning in the Capel. This service is approximately 15 mins.

21. **Camp will close at 10:30 am on Sunday.**
