WANT TO SET UP A BOOTH?

Packs from all districts are asked to set up an Adventure Loop or Pin booth. Bring your own canopies, tables, chairs, etc for Tanah Keeta. **We cannot have a successful event without Pack participation!**

Pick an Adventure Loop or Pin for your pack. Get all your leaders and parents involved...make a schedule for the event, so you're not the only one at the booth. Ask everyone to volunteer for an hour so you can enjoy time with your scout at the event. The best set up for these booths are Round Robins within each booth: set up requirements by table and rotate scouts to each one. Expect 30 to 45 minutes per each Rank requirement booth for completion.
