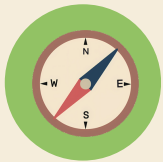
WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE CONFERENCE?

We would love to gather anyone involved in Scouting camp, camping, our outdoor programs in the Southeast. That includes Cubs, Scouts BSA, Venturing, and Ships. Volunteers, professionals, and enthusiasts are all welcome!



DO I HAVE TO CAMP, OR CAN I STAY INDOORS?

We are planning to have everyone stay in roofed housing for the weekend - either in our staff lodge or in cabins. Should event attendance exceed our indoor housing capacity, some participants may be asked to camp. Of course camping is also always an option! Register early to ensure you get a spot!



WHAT IF WE HAVE TO ARRIVE LATE OR LEAVE EARLY?

No problem! We have set the schedule to account for longer travel times, so registration is open from 3pm-10pm Friday and on Saturday morning. The last full-group gathering is breakfast Sunday so participants needing to leave early will just have to miss a class session.



WHAT IS THE TYPICAL WEATHER?

Fall in the North Georgia Mountains is usually pleasant and crisp. Expect daytime temperatures in the mid-70's and overnight temps in the mid 50's. Rain is always a possibility, as are temps above and below the norm.



WHAT SHOULD I PLAN TO WEAR?

Wear your favorite casual Scouting clothes. We are in the mountains, so good footwear is a must. Layers and rain gear are always a good idea.
