2027 Registration Fees

What the Fees Include

Off-site activities: Each youth fee includes one off site activity: a Nantahala River trip, an Ocoee River trip, or the Horsemanship Merit Badge. Each additional off-site activity costs \$70 and must be paid before arrival or during business checkout. Scouts taking both Whitewater and Horsemanship Merit Badges pay one additional \$70 activity fee.

Additional program fees: Some adult programs and certifications, including Wilderness First Aid, CPR, and IOLS, may have additional fees. Specialty youth experiences and certifications may also cost extra. Review all class descriptions and the Leader Guide before finalizing schedules.

High Adventure Experiences ages 14 and older: Pathfinder and Whitewater Challenge each cost an additional \$100. The fee is due with the unit final balance two weeks before arrival. Venturing participants aged 18 to 20 register at the youth rate and pay the \$100 high adventure fee for a total registration fee of \$650.

Payments may be made online or mailed to the council office. Mailed payments must include the unit number, the unit council, Woodruff Scout Camp, and the reservation week. Incidental charges are due before departure during business checkout.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- A full refund, less the \$300 nonrefundable deposit, requires a written request emailed to Woodruff@AtlantaBSA.org at least 30 days before the Sunday arrival date.
- Cancellations for youth or adults made 14 to 30 days before arrival receive a 50 percent refund after all fees are paid.
- Within 14 days of the event, refunds are at the discretion of the event coordinator or staff advisor.
- To avoid penalties, cancel off site activities by emailing Woodruff@AtlantaBSA.org at least two weeks before the unit arrives.

Adult Leader Bonus

Woodruff offers free full week adult registrations based on the number of Scouts attending with each unit. The qualifying adult must be registered and present for four or more days. Partial week adults may not qualify, and days may not be combined among different adults to create a full week registration.

Scouts attending	Free full week adults
Fewer than 5	0
5 to 24	2
25 to 34	3
35 to 44	4
45 to 54	5
55 to 64	6
65 to 74	7
75 or more	8

Example

A unit brings 12 Scouts and qualifies for two free full week adults. Four adults plan to cover the week as shown below. Only Leader A qualifies for a free registration because Leader A is the only adult attending four or more days. The second bonus cannot be split among partial week leaders but may apply to **one** of the partial week adults.

Leader	Days attending	Fee	Explanation
A	4 days	Free	Qualifies for one Adult Leader Bonus
B	2 days	\$160	Partial week; does not qualify
C	3 days	Free	Partial week; may qualify
D	3 days	\$240	Partial week; does not qualify

Adult Registration Rules

- Adults attending one to three days pay \$80 per day. The rate covers meals and the camp stay.
- An adult attending four or more days is considered a full week adult and pays the \$300 discounted full week fee.
- A full week registration must be assigned to one person. Partial week adults may not combine their days to create a full week registration.
