Online registration must be completed 1 week prior to the camporee. The cost will be \$25 per attendee, (both adult and scout).

Camping will be in the Flint River Adventure Area, Leslie campsite, mostly in platforms. There is limited space for personal tents.

Health and Safety:

Water will be available and electricity in limited availability.

Fires only in portable or existing fire pits.

Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times. For climbing you will need to remember closed toed shoes. This is a requirement for climbing. Shoes with a tread are best.

Anyone leaving/returning must sign out/in at the camporee headquarters

No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs. No tobacco use or smoking within 50 yards downwind of any scout or scouting activity. This includes ecigarettes, personal vaporizers or electronic nicotine delivery systems that simulate tobacco smoking.

All units must have two-deep leadership at all times. In addition to this all Girl Troops must have one female adult leader.

All adults attending are encouraged to take the Climb on Safely course prior to camp online at https://www.scouting.org/outdoor-programs/cope/climb-on-safely/

Emergencies: Health, weather, other: Should any emergencies occur, please send a unit representative to the camporee headquarters for instructions.

Meals:

Troops are responsible for their own meals.

Uniforms:

Class A: We will wear Class A (or field Uniform) at Campfire and Vespers

Class B: We will wear the Class B T-shirt at all other activities.

Maintaining Order:

The Scout Oath and Law are the rules of Camporee. Scouts unable to abide by these guidelines will be asked to leave.

Arrow of Light Attendance:

Arrow of Light scouts may attend Camporee provided they follow the current Guide to Safe Scouting rules here:

- Arrow of Light Scouts may participate at a Scouts BSA "camporee" (council coordinated, short-term camp, see NCAP SA-001) during the day and/or overnight in one of two ways:
 - I. With their Arrow of Light Den/Patrol. Arrow of Light Scouts can attend as an Arrow of Light den/patrol under the supervision of two deep leadership from their Arrow of Light den/patrol or pack. The Arrow of Light Scout's parent or legal guardian(s) may attend with the Arrow of Light den/patrol and their child, either alongside the two-deep leadership or as part of it if they are registered with the pack. Or
 - II. As an Individual Scout. Arrow of Light Scouts can attend with their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if the local council coordinates two deep leadership per NCAP Standard HS-502.

Please note: Webelos Scouts and Webelos Scout dens may not participate at a Scouts BSA troop unit campout or at a Scouts BSA "camporee" or other events designed for Scouts BSA during the day and/or overnight, even as visitors.

AOL's from Pack 163 and Pack 66 will coordinate some AOL only activities.
