- District 2024 Derby Rules will be Strictly Enforced for Den and Sibling Races: Derby cars MUST have been made THIS scouting year. Pre-assembled purchased Derby Cars violate the spirit of the Pinewood Derby and will not be permitted. Remember the "PURPOSE of the Derby is to help the Cub Scout build a team relationship with their parent(s)/guardian, experience a sense of accomplishment and the excitement of competition, learn Good Sportsmanship, and to have FUN."
- Sibling Race will also follow District 2024 Derby Rules: Siblings will use same rules as Cub Scouts.
- Adult Race is "Outlaw" with NO Rules: Cars must fit on the track and pass under finish line.
