KLONDIKE DERBY NOTES

- 1. Two nights of camping available for Scouts BSA Troops and Venturing Crews
- 2. Webelos will not be allowed to camp
- 3. No ground campfires must use burn barrel or fire pit
- 4. Units responsible for their own meals
- 5. Trailers will be dropped at a specific location to maximize parking
- 6. Carpooling should be encouraged
- 7. Participants must stay away from the ponds
- 8. Patrols/Dens must follow the event schedule they are assigned. If they go out of order to events, points will be deducted.
- 9. Adults are not allowed to accompany or coach the Scouts BSA Patrols. If they do, it will be noted on the scoresheet and reported when the score is radioed in. Points will be deducted for adult interference. Webelos Dens can have adults with them, but the adults should *minimize* the help they offer the Webelos Scouts.
