

## **Potomac Heritage Trail Ride Itinerary**

**Day 1 Tues 6/11:** Fly Chicago to DC. Arr 9:00 am Picked up in vans and taken into the city for sightseeing. Pick up and return to campsite late afternoon. Set up tents and Remain Over Night (RON) at Ft. Belvoir, VA \$20/space

**Day 2 Wed Jun 12:** Start at Mt. Vernon. Cross to DC and go to obelisk indicating start of the C&O Tow Path. Ride trail to Swain's Lock MM 15 Distance: 35 miles

**Day 3 Thu Jun 13:** Swain's Lock to [White's Ferry is MM35.5] Point of Rocks MM 49 Calico Rocks Camp Site 33 miles

**Day 4 Fri Jun 14:** PoR to MM 79.5 Horseshoe Bend Campsite 30.5 miles Visit Harper's Ferry at MM 60.5.

**Day 5 Sat Jun 15:** MM 79.5 to MM 109 North Mountain Campsite 30.5 miles

**Day 6 Sun Jun 16:** MM 109 to MM 156 Paw Paw Tunnel Campground 38 miles Traverse Paw Paw Tunnel (3100 feet)

**Day 7 Mon Jun 17:** MM 156 to MM 180 Evitts Creek Campsite. Cumberland could be a motel night for showers, etc.

**Day 8 Tue Jun 18:** Train from Cumberland to Frostburg, MD Western Maryland RR. 4 hours on the train \$50.00 per ticket. Camp in Frostburg at MM 15

**Day 9 Wed Jun 19:** MM 15 to MM 44.5 Rockwood 29.5 miles

**Day 10 Thu Jun 20:** MM to MM 72 Ohiopyle State Park Campground

**Day 11 Fri Jun 21:** MM 72 to MM 99 Roundbottom Campground

**Day 12 Sat Jun 22:** MM 99 to MM 131 McKeesport or MM 139.5 Homestead—motel only

**Day 13 Sun Jun 23:** Above to End of Trail at Point State Park in Pittsburgh 25 or 15 miles. Ground transport to airport motel.

**Day 14 Mon Jun 24:** Airport shuttle. Fly home to Chicago
